Off Site School Social Event(s)

As voluntary participants in school social events, students shall be held responsible for compliance with rules set forth for their conduct, and infractions of those rules will be subject to the same disciplinary measures applicable during the regular school program.

Participation in school events is not a right and may be denied to any student who has demonstrated disregard for the rules of the school.

The Superintendent shall develop administrative guidelines for the conduct of student social events which shall include:

- A. Designation of a staff member who shall be the Board employee responsible for the event;
- B. Provision for chaperonage, adult supervision, and/or police protection required by the circumstances of the event;
- C. Provisions for the safety of all students and adults involved.

Those using an off campus site must be aware of and adhere to the State of Michigan concussion law which requires all coaches, employees, volunteers, and other adults involved with a youth athletic activity to complete a concussion awareness on-line training program.

The Board of Education will permit the use of an off campus school social event when such permission has been requested in writing by a responsible organization or a group of citizens and has been approved by the Principal and the Superintendent.

No liability shall attach to this District, any employee, officer, or member of this District specifically as a consequence of permitting an off campus school social event.
